Key Stage 3

Each faculty and subject area within it should have an agreed policy which is used to inform parents or guardians and pastoral staff of students' progress where praise or concern is appropriate.

Key Stage 4

After the mock examinations in October, subject staff identify pupils who are not working to their full potential or who are behind with their coursework.

A letter will be sent home to parents from subject teachers and support and guidance is offered to the pupils (1/2 term revision classes are available).
